The Tribunal will hold a hearing at (time and date) to determine the validity of the fine and either confirm or reject it. You are welcomed to attend this hearing in order to be heard. The Tribunal will send you written notice of their decision and, if appropriate, you will have five (5) days from the date of that notice to pay the fine. If the fine is rejected by the Tribunal, no further action by the Board will be taken, and the 2nd violation will be removed from your records.
